

# Business Web Design I

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

This semester course provides students with a major emphasis on the principles and design of a website as well as advanced Internet skills and techniques. HTML, Web publishing, and graphic editing software will be used to design, create, format, and edit Web pages.

## STANDARDS AND OBJECTIVES

The goals of this course are to help students:

1. demonstrate a basic knowledge of the Internet and the tools used to access information
2. plan and design a website using principles of good design
3. use HTML (hypertext markup language) to create attractive Web pages
4. use commercial Web design software (Macromedia Dreamweaver) to create attractive Web pages
5. create and prepare images to integrate with web site designs

## DESIRED RESULTS FOR STUDENT LEARNING

The desired results for student learning at CVHS are Competent Learner, Effective Communicator, and Responsible Citizen. Each of the goals listed above will address Competent Learner and Effective Communicator. A discussion of copyright laws related to Web design will address Responsible Citizenship.

## EXPECTATIONS

**To successfully complete the course, students need to:**

- attend each class period (on time)
- stay on task (use only software programs and Internet as instructed)
- complete assigned work accurately, neatly, and on time
- study and be prepared for quizzes, other assessments, and the state competency test
- participate in class discussions and group activities
- respect the teacher and other students in the classroom
- follow district (Student Acceptable Use Policy) and classroom computer policies\*

## COMPUTER PRIVILEGES

- Students are assigned a computer and will be responsible for the machine and its use during class time.
- Students will log in to computers with a Username (assigned by the teacher) and Password (student choice). Passwords are to be kept confidential in order to ensure that work is not lost or tampered with.
- Students are given server space to store only those files related to course assignments.
- Students are given access to the Internet to use only for course assignments.

Inappropriate conduct or behavior on classroom computers will result in loss of these computer privileges.

**No food or drinks are allowed near the computers in the computer classroom.**

## GRADING CRITERIA

**Each student is graded on the following:**

- Bell work assignments and quizzes (that **cannot** be made up if late)
- Attendance/participation
- Instruction exercises
- Projects
- Assessments (including state competency test given at the end of the semester)

The student is responsible for completing all classroom work assigned. The majority of the student's grade will be based on the accuracy and meeting of deadlines for each exercise and project. Being in class and on time are very important to the student's grade. Immediately upon returning to school following an excused absence, the student must make arrangements to complete any missed exercises or assessments. Assignments missed on a day that a student has an unexcused absence cannot be made up.

Assessments will be given following each unit. The state CTE competency test will be given at the end of the semester. Students scoring 80% or higher will be awarded a state certificate.
