### Why

Local individuals & businesses have donated over \$20,000 for scholarships. Scholarships may be used for any institution of higher education or training.

## The Portfolios

Each student will be required to complete a portfolio. Students will need one portfolio for each scholarship that they plan to apply for. Business dress please!

### Portfolio Guideline

**Required Materials:** Clear front, 3-tang fastener report cover, 4 sheet protectors and high quality paper.

Portfolios should contain **only** the following and in the order listed:

1. Cover Page that contains a picture, name and educational goal.
2. Educational Resume
3. Essay on “Why post-secondary education is for me” (1 page, double spaced, size 12 font, 1 inch margins, 300 words maximum)
4. Transcript (does not need to be official)
5. 3 Letters of Recommendation. Two of the letters must be from someone not associated with your school (i.e. teacher, counselor, coach, etc...)
6. Financial Need & Digital Footprint Form

Templates and forms can be downloaded at [www.suu.edu/trioets](http://www.suu.edu/trioets). Portfolios should be printed black and white. Only the cover page with picture should be in color. Seven pages total with the eighth page reserved for additional applications if required.
