January 14, 2020

Approval of Minutes: T Hulet made a motion to approved the November 2019 minutes. J Newman second.
Vote: Unanimous.

Positive Based Intervention System (PBIS):

D Heaton reported that CVHS Admin and Faculty have collaborated to draft a PBIS policy that will be very successful. Board members reviewed and discussed documents and made suggestions and comments. Board members are pleased with the progress and results.

Standards Based Grading (SBG):

D Heaton lead a discussion on SBG. Every CVHS teacher has been trained in SBG. Iron County School District teachers are working refining the system and solving some issues. The goal is to implement SBG next fall throughout the District Schools. Mastery Connect will be the system used to provide grade information. Board members expressed some frustration and concerns with SBG. D Heaton reminded that for SBG to work, it must have assessments that are clear to everyone and are displayed clearly. He encouraged the CV Community to identify things that can be controlled and continue to move forward.

Social Emotional Learning (SEL):

CVHS is working to develop policies that will help students in this area.

Positive Behavior Intervention System (PBIS):

D Heaton presented signage drafts of the latest PBIS policy for CVHS. The policy includes acceptable behavior in Classroom, Commons, Hallway, Bathroom, Assemblies, and Auditorium. The theme centers on the Ahhhhhhhhhh CV anthem, and includes Ahhhhh-countability, Civility, and Valor. Board members are supportive and appreciate the work and efforts being made by CV Faculty.

Data Reports:

D Heaton reviewed the following Data Reports: School Plan, ACT Profile, AP Testing Profile, Concurrent Enrollment Profile Indicators, CVHS Grading Distributions, and Learning Strategies Credit Recovery Programs. Board members discussed specific questions.

Trust Lands Budget:

D Heaton distributed and discussed Trust Lands expenditures. He requested that Board members review these reports and come to the next meeting prepared to discuss possible expenditures on technology (for a laptop/PC lab), FLEX period spending, and remediation. He will send out specific proposals before the next meeting.

Counselors Report:

A Whiting reported that the CV Counseling office is developing future resources that will be very beneficial to CV students. Currently, they are working on going greatly expanding the resilience training. This would include grade specific resources to help students at each age. They hope to strengthen student/teacher relationships and give tools that promote positivity. She discussed other ideas that are in the work

Other:

D Heaton reported that several teachers will be leaving CVHS to go to the new Launch High School. Some of the teachers are currently teaching AP and Concurrent Enrollment courses. SUU is working to help other CV teachers become qualified to teach these classes. He emphasized that good things are happening at Canyon View High School. It is his goal to keep programs in place that are working well, and continue to develop and refine new ideas.

After a short discussion, T Hulet made a motion to change the next Community Council meeting to March 31st. J Pollock second. Vote: Unanimous
