This Student is being assigned a Chromebook and Case for the 2020-21 school year. The Student will be expected to maintain possession of the Chromebook and Case. The School District shall retain ownership of the Chromebook (ownership does not transfer to Student). This Chromebook is both a required and necessary element of Student learning, in the same manner as a school textbook.

This Chromebook shall only be used by the Student for which it is assigned. The Student shall not permit this Chromebook to be used by friends, other students, or other family members. The Student shall not use a School Chromebook which has been assigned to another Student.

This Student must bring the Chromebook to School each (attending) day, with a ***fully-charged*** battery. While at School, the Chromebook should remain in the possession of the Student at all times and not be left unattended (should not be left in a locker or at the School overnight).

This Student has a responsibility for maintaining proper care of the Chromebook and to keep the Chromebook in its protective case when transporting. Normal "wear and tear" of the Chromebook is anticipated. However, abuse or misuse resulting in damage, whether intentional or not, may have repair costs. Should the Chromebook become damaged or considered non-functional, a temporary replacement (Chromebook) shall be assigned by the School while damages are assessed. Repair costs shall be the responsibility of the Parent. The Parent may opt for Chromebook Insurance (see **Insurance & Repairs**).

This Chromebook shall be filtered by the Iron County School District network and firewall any time the Chromebook is connected to the internet. While a Student may opt to use his or her personal device from home, personal Chromebooks cannot be used at School (personal Chromebooks are not capable of joining the School District network and cannot be filtered; personal hotspots are not permitted at School).

At the conclusion of the current school year this Chromebook and protective case shall be returned to the School where it was originally assigned. The Chromebook will be assessed for damages. The Parent will be responsible for costs of repair. (see **Insurance & Repairs**).

## Insurance & Repairs

The Parent has the option of purchasing School insurance at the amount of **\$20 for each assigned Chromebook** (per year, to be collected at the beginning of each school year).

This will insure the Student-assigned School Chromebook against the following repairs and circumstances, except in specific instances of \*Misuse (as noted below):

Cracked or Damaged Screen ..... \$20

Broken Keys or Keyboard ..... \$4 each Key / \$20 Full Keyboard

Lost/Damaged AC Adapter ..... \$15

Lost/Damaged Protective Case .... \$15

Chromebook Replacement ..... \$225

\*Misuse: The insurance option is designed to cover all costs for repair, to include full replacement, should the Chromebook stop functioning while under normal use. However, the insurance option does not cover the costs of repair or replacement resulting from intentional acts of destruction, inappropriate use, carelessness, theft, or other acts of malice regardless of who has possession of the Chromebook at the time of the neglect and misuse. All costs for repair or replacement under such conditions of misuse will be the responsibility of the parent.
